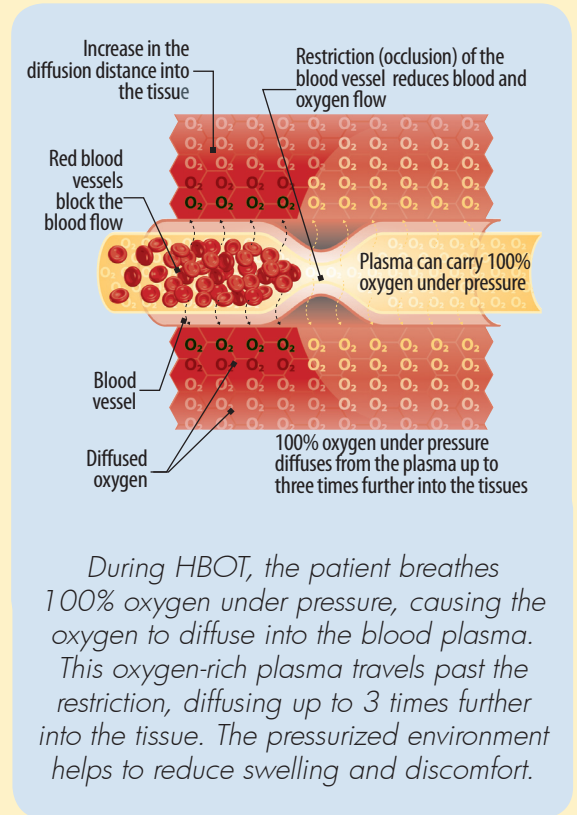

Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy (HBOT)

Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy (HBOT) is one of several advanced treatment modalities offered by the Advanced Wound Center. HBOT allows for an increase of 10 times in plasma oxygen concentration, thereby accelerating the wound healing process.



Indications for Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy

- Diabetic Foot Ulcers
- Refractory Osteomyelitis
- Osteoradionecrosis
- Soft Tissue Radionecrosis
- Compromised Skin Graft/Flap
- Crush Injuries
- Necrotizing Infections
- Gas Gangrene
- Arterial Insufficiency
- Acute CO Poisoning
